Jr. Handling & Pee-wee: 3-5 Pee-wee, 6-7 Sub Jr., 8-12 Novice, 8-12 Open, 13-17 Novice, 13-17 Open

Regular Altered & Intact (Divided by Sex): 6-9, 9-12, 12-18, Novice, American Bred, Bred By Exhibitor, Open Blue Merle, Open Red Merle, Open Black, Open Red, Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Best of Breed

Directions from West: Traveling eastbound on the CA-91 Fwy, pass Weir Canyon Road. Take Exit 41 for Gypsum Canyon Road. Turn left at the bottom of the off-ramp. Pass under freeway and turn left at the signal. This will lead you right into our entrance.

Directions from East: Traveling westbound on the CA-91 Fwy toward Beach Cities, pass Green River Road. Take Exit 41A for Gypsum Canyon Road. At the bottom of the off-ramp continue straight through the signal into our entrance.

Canyon RV Park rules gate opens at 8 am it will be \$5 per car to get in and the entrance booth will be open until noon, after that guests will have to park and walk up to the office to pay. Closing time is 8 pm. Please keep your dogs on leash and pick up after your dogs.

Bring plenty of wind and sun protection, please stake down your canopies securely

All entries must be on a current ASCA entry form (Rev. 5, 01-02-02). Juniors must use a separate entry form for each day; all others may use one form for both days. All entries must be completed (with agreement signed on back) or they will be refused. Dogs 6 months & over must have ASCA Registration number on the entry form.

No entry shall be accepted from a dog or handler disqualified from the ASCA conformation program; a dog or handler disqualified from all ASCA programs; or a person not in good standing with ASCA

ASCA sanction pending – events will be held under current rules and regulations of ASCA

Entry fees will not be refunded if the dog is absent, disqualified, excused or barred from competition by the show committee, ASCA, the show veterinarian or the judge
